SHOW DESCRIPTION

The Young Americans' first act is designed to be the final teaching experience for the workshop. Not only is it a thank you to students and the community, but it helps to reinforce everything that was taught in the previous two workshop days. The students get front row seats to watch The Young Americans perform a variety show full of hip-hop, choral, Broadway, contemporary, jazz, rock n' roll and music from well known artists like Shania Twain, Aretha Franklin, Celine Dion, The Temptations, The Four Seasons, The Beach Boys, N'SYNC, One Direction and more. The finale will be a medley from one of Broadway's most well known musicals.

The students' second act opener is a hip-hop number, Turn Up The Music. Our choral medley will feature music from some of the greatest songs from today including FUN, Phillip Phillips, and One Direction. Then we'll experience music from the decades and travel from the gramophone all the way to the iPad and YouTube. Next, we'll feature songs the students themselves have written and choreographed. Fresh off Broadway, we'll see selections from Matilda, Annie, Newsies, Les Mis and The Lion King. Act Two has a great balance of singing, dancing and acting all in one.
